PROGRAMME DURATION

The programme is delivered over 6 x 3 day modules in year 1 and 8 x 1 day action learning seminars in year 2. Classes run from 9.00am – 5.00pm each day. All teaching is held on the Institute's premises in Sandyford, Dublin 18

PROGRAMME FEES

The fees for the programme are €8,000 in year 1 for EU Students and €16,000 for non EU Students. For the MSc a further €4,500 is payable in year 2 for EU students and €9,000 for non EU Students. Fees are payable in instalments.

Delivered in: Ireland, Bahrain and United Arab Emirates

Delivery method: Blended learning using a combination of classroom and web-based instruction.

Duration: Two Years Part-time

Flexibility & Progression: You can obtain an MSc within 2-5 years of registration. There is a provision to exit with a Postgraduate Certificate after completing the first 3 modules within 1-2 years and a Postgraduate Diploma after completing all 6 modules within 1-3 years of registration.

The Programme

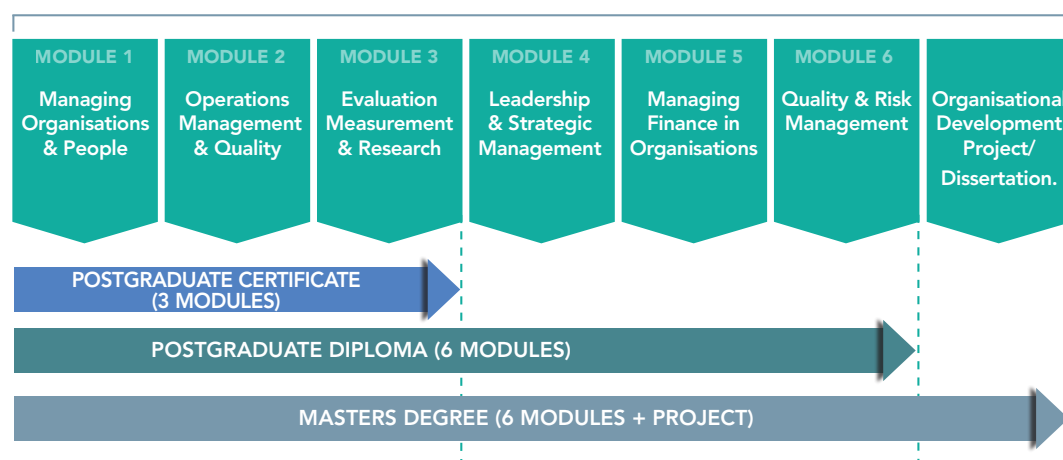
